

Eligibility Requirements for the Out-of-State Fee Waiver (HB 851)

In accordance to Florida Statute 1009.26(12)(a) students may request an out-of-state fee waiver provided they submit a high school transcript which shows they have attended a Florida secondary school for three consecutive years immediately preceding high school graduation, and proof that they have applied for enrollment to the Florida College System institution within 24 months of high school graduation.

- Official high school transcript showing graduation date and three consecutive years of attendance. The Out-of-State Fee Wavier cannot be processed without an official high school transcript which confirms graduation.
